The FCCSB Transition House FoodTeam fed ~ 55 residents and the evening manager at the TH Shelter April 8th. Peter Brown, Suzanne Brown, Peter Fordand I Bud Kayser, MaryAnn Lund and I each arrived around 5:30 pm. We all set to making the next-day lunches or finishing up the meal preparations. Lynn Stewart came in a bit later, accompan-ied by her daughter, Jacqui and Jacqui's husband, Bob. Jacqui & Bob put together the salad materials they brought, then left us.

A bit before 6:15 we had a short prayer of thanksgiving for the opportunity to work together and serve those who are working to stabilize their lives. Bud left and we set up to serve dinner.

The two Peters, Suzanne and Lynn served slices of warmed French bread (the Browns), oven-BBQ'dchicken pieces,* rice,* refried beans,* carrots and green salad (both from Lynn) along with orange (fruit from MaryAnn's tree) wedges for the children. Butter* was out on each of the tables. Sliced jalapenos,* salsa* and grated cheese* were on a side table near the serving counter for those who wished.

I prepped plates of Nancy Chase's Choc. chip cake for dessert to be passed out once the dinner was served. MaryAnn stood by to refill serving dishes, etc.. Once dinner and dessert were served and the late plates were prepped, Lynn and the Browns put together plates for themselves and sat down to eat. Peter F. packed up the leftovers—I still must refrain from lifting anything--and we hurried home to eat our dinner, clean our kitchen and put away the extra food.
