# WHAT'S GOING ON? LOTS OF EXCITING THINGS HAPPENING! TRANSITION COMMITTEE UPDATE 1

Dear Friends of FCCSB and Way Collective,

We are grateful to share that the Transition Committee—made up of representatives from both First Congregational Church Santa Barbara and Way Collective—has met for the first time. Our work together has begun with energy, openness, and a deep sense of hope for what lies ahead.

At this initial meeting, we focused on two important areas: the **naming of our new collaborative** and the first draft of potential **bylaws and governance structures**. Both of these conversations reflect our shared desire to honor the rich histories of our communities while also creating space for fresh expressions of faith, contemplation, and justice in Santa Barbara.

We know how important it is that the whole community stays connected and informed during this process. With that in mind, we will be sharing regular updates as our work continues to unfold. If you have any questions or comments during this

process, please reach out to your committee members or myself—we welcome your voice and input.

Today, we are excited to share with you the results of the **naming process** that emerged from our discussions.

#### New Collaborative Naming Proposal

**ONE: A Christian Collaborative of Santa Barbara** is the joining of two historic congregations — First Congregational Church SB (United Church of Christ) and First Christian Church SB (Disciples of Christ). Together we are creating **One Christian Community Gatherings**, with classic and current expressions on Sunday mornings, and Way **Collective**, a contemplative dinner-and-dialogue on Wednesday evenings, along with regular meditation offerings. In this shared life, we honor our "First" history by learning to prioritize oneness — with God, with one another, with other faith traditions, and with our city. We exist to carry forward the communal wisdom of contemplation and the work of justice, shaping a Christianity rooted in ancient spiritual practices and renewing for generations to come.

#### **Tim's New Title:**

**Curating Minister** — This title comes from the ancient word *cura*, meaning "care of souls." To curate is to tend, arrange, and make space for what is sacred. As a combination of both his current titles of Core Curator and Bridge Minister, the Curating Minister will work to hold together the pastoral and the contemplative, guiding our community in vision, worship, justice, and shared life with intention and care.

**Timeline** 

- September–October: Governance & Structure, Identity & Mission (drafting proposals)
- October-November: Finance & Administration, Property & Facilities (initial integration plans)
- November–December: Worship & Programs, Communication & Rituals (community engagement and celebration planning)
- **December:** Finalize transition roadmap and prepare for January 1, 2026 launch

Please know that these are our proposed recommendations. Nothing in this process is final until we have a congregational vote (hopefully in late December) to adopt the proposals that will come out of our work this Fall. This is just the beginning, and there is much more to come. We are

committed to a process that is transparent, participatory, and guided by love. Thank you for walking with us in this journey of becoming something new together.
